The CIFAR Azrieli Global Scholars program provides funding, skills training, mentorship, and opportunities to collaborate with colleagues from diverse disciplines, positioning scholars as research leaders and agents of change.

### Opportunity

CIFAR Azrieli Global Scholars receive:

- » \$100,000 CAD in unrestricted research support
- » A two-year term in a CIFAR research program, a global network of top-tier research leaders
- » Opportunities to network, collaborate and form a community with colleagues from diverse disciplines
- » Mentorship from a senior researcher within a CIFAR research program
- » Specialized leadership and communication skills training, and support to put their skills into action

Upon completion of the program, CIFAR Azrieli Global Scholars will have strengthened skills, an expanded network of research collaborators from across disciplines, experience engaging leaders across sectors, and the capacity and the excitement to continue to tackle complex questions in novel ways.
